



District 10 Garden Grant Program

Single District 10 Lions Clubs will provide matching grants of up to \$500.00 to be used for the purposes of establishing School or Community Gardens or Farm to School educational programming in District 10 in order to assist in the promotion of the mission of Lions HUNGER in their local communities.

Clubs that apply for the grant must be current with District 10 and Lions International dues and be in good standing with District 10 and Lions International. A requesting club may only apply for one garden grant from District 10.

The grant application must be submitted by the current President of the Lions Club and have the approval of the club membership in order to apply. (provide an official copy of meeting minutes with the application)

The requesting club must submit a proposed budget of expenses for the grant project/program and directly oversee the administration of the grant funding. All necessary documents must be provided in order for the grant to be considered.

Qualifying Expenses:

Expenses directly tied to the construction of gardens (Farm 2 School or Community Garden) seed, fencing, soil, fertilizer, tools or the implementation of Farm to School programs.
